

2018 NWAC Volleyball Showcase, Aug. 25-26, 2018

Welcome to the third annual NWAC Volleyball Showcase, held at Bob Keefer Sports and Recreation Center in Springfield, Oregon. Please read the following information and schedule. If you have any questions, contact VB Chair Kathie Woods at idget@aol.com.

Basic information and format:

1. The tournament is set up so that every team will play 6, 2 out of 3 set matches. The deciding set will be to 15 points. All matches are won by 2 points with no cap. No team will play a team from their own region, with the exception of Big Bend CC (BMCC (updated 7/24/18) and TVCC), which will be an "alternate North representative", which will fill in for a smaller Northern region, as we discussed and agreed on in our annual coaches meeting. This will create 4 "regions", called N, W, A and C! (Notice it is NOT North, South, East and West). This adjustment needed to be made because of the uneven numbers of teams in each region.
2. The 2017 league standings (see below) were used to create the schedule. The top 2 from each region will play the other top 2's from the other regions for their 6 matches (excluding teams from their own region). This will be the same for the 3rd and 4th place finishers, 5th and 6th place finishers and the 7th and 8th place finishers.
3. There are no winners or awards declared in this showcase tournament. Stats will not be turned into the NWAC. The philosophy is to get to play as many teams as possible, playing other regions (with an exception). Each team is guaranteed 6 matches.
4. All teams will play on both sport courts and wood courts. Courts 1-4 are sport courts and courts 5-8 are wood courts.
5. Each team will officiate twice (once on Saturday and once on Sunday). Teams on Sunday will have shared responsibilities.

Officials: R1 and R2 will be provided on each court by OVCOA for **all matches**. The teams are responsible for 2 lines people, a libero tracker, score card flipper and a *previously trained* scorebook person per court. Please see attached schedule for your team's responsibility.

Trainer: A trainer will be available throughout the tournament. Please bring your own supplies. Ice will be available in limited supply.

Schedule: See attached. We will try to stay on schedule as much as possible. If we get ahead of schedule, the match may start early, if agreed upon by both coaches and officials.

Warm-up protocol: There are 2 courts open for warm up possibilities. Teams that have not played for the day will have priority of those courts. Teams may also warm up outside on the grass. Teams will be guaranteed a minimum of 10 min. warm-up between matches (5 min. and 5 min.)

Game ball: Game ball is Baden Perfection. Please bring your own team balls and carts for warm-up. Game balls will be provided. Your carts and balls can be kept at the facility overnight, if you wish.

Locker Room: Please bring your own towels and locks if you plan to use the facility.

Hospitality Room: There will be a coaches and officials hospitality room available.
